Job description:

We are looking for a Project Controller with experience in business accounting or financial project management. In detail, the role is to analyse, advise and control the budget of the H2020 funded once-only principle project (TOOP) in correspondence with European Commission and 50 high-level organisations from 22 countries. The project's scope is to pilot the once-only principle in the European Union and beyond. The "once-only" principle assumes that collecting the same data multiple times is more expensive than sharing and reusing data that has already been collected. Thus, projects aim is to reduce the administrative burden of businesses and public administrations. Tallinn University of Technology, RNS, serves as a coordinator of the project. Project's duration is 30 months.

Skill requirements

- A minimum of MA degree in business administration, economics, management, public administration or related.
- Demonstrable ability and previous experience of financial management and substantial project budget oversight.
- Independent navigation in financial rules and standards and their effective communication to partner organisations.
- Proven experience to analyse and control finances on time, on budget, in scope with high quality.
- Proven ability of working efficiently as part of a wider, multi-disciplinary team in a cross-functional work environment.
- High level of skills and experience in using Excel.
